




Cultivated Land








FARM SALES BY CATEGORY AND STATE RANK FOR ONONDAGA COUNTY



Cost for public services per dollar revenue raised
















Vision

The state of agriculture in Onondaga County has seen significant changes over the years. Through it all, local agriculture remains a critical part of its economy, food system, and landscape. The county is gifted with highly productive agricultural soils, a legacy of farming operations and know-how, and an environment that supports a highly diverse array of agriculture and opportunities to engage with the local food system. This plan honors the strengths of Onondaga County's agriculture and reflects these strengths in a vision for the future of agriculture throughout the county:

Onondaga County is a dynamic agricultural community of vibrant, resilient, and experienced farm operators and farm-related entrepreneurs who are the stewards of local viable farmland and the food system.

GOALS



Enhance agriculture-related economic development activities and collaboration to capitalize on emerging markets, technologies, and incentives.



Strategically protect agricultural lands throughout Onondaga County to sustain and improve its vibrant agricultural operations.



Promote the importance of local agriculture and food systems throughout Onondaga County.



Support the next generation of farmers and agricultural entrepreneurs in Onondaga County.



Continue to enhance the relationship between agriculture and the natural environment.









Enhance agriculture-related economic development activities and collaboration to capitalize on emerging markets, technologies, and incentives.

- Agricultural Economic Development Coordinator
- Food hub (e.g., agricultural business park)
- Trainings offering certifications in value-added production and business development
- Broadband improvement
- Offer agricultural technological services (e.g., drones) to local producers
- Commercial kitchen for startup operations to develop value-added products







Strategically protect agricultural lands throughout Onondaga County to sustain and improve its vibrant agricultural operations.

- Increase funding/capacity to protect farmland
- "Strike the right balance" for solar development on farmland
- Provide adequate technical assistance for local land trusts
- Update comprehensive plans + local regulations to support agriculture
- Encourage towns to create their own agricultural protection plans







Promote the importance of local agriculture and food systems throughout Onondaga County.

- Increase public awareness of the Onondaga Grown Campaign
- Grow OnFarm Fest programming







Support the next generation of farmers and agricultural entrepreneurs in Onondaga County.

- Develop "New Farmer Program"
 - Incubator programs that provide land and other resources
 - Manager-in-training programs through mentorship
 - Technical assistance to link aspiring farmers with potential land or loan programs
- Trainings for high-tech agriculture
- Training for agri-service professionals to support succession planning and direct farmers to appropriate stress-related support services







Continue to enhance the relationship between agriculture and the natural environment.

- Agricultural waste stream analysis
- Water quality evaluation and assistance for farmers
- Assistance for climate resiliency, nutrient management, precision technology
- Increase funding for programs that protect soil health




