

## Onondaga County Agritourism Grant Program

Dear Onondaga County Agricultural Community:

Onondaga County is seeking to partner with the local agricultural community to enhance the viability of our valuable farmland and protect farms and farm operators for future generations. In recognition of the role that agritourism plays in farm viability, tourism, and quality of life in Onondaga County, I am pleased to share the **Onondaga County Agritourism Grant Program**, with individual awards of up to \$15,000 to agritourism ventures.

For these purposes, agritourism is defined as a commercial farm enterprise that links local agricultural production and/or processing with tourism to attract visitors for the purposes of entertaining and/or educating the visitors, while generating income to support the farm.

These grants may be used to cover a variety of projects to grow and enhance agritourism operations in four general categories: *Improve, Expand, Initiate and Market*. Funds may be used for projects or programs such as expanding or diversifying operations, improving safety and ease of access, or adding new educational programming. New agritourism ventures may use the funding to help offset costs of getting started on a new venture or product.

Agritourism operators are encouraged to be creative. Your submissions will help us to know better what your needs, and the needs of the agritourism community, are. If this grant program cannot fulfill your needs, please contact us to explore possible options. Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis, until funds run out.
